Mr. Wimsatt gave a brief synopsis on the 2013-2014 budgets; He also talked about the closure of the Farmington Cardinal Landfill. He also talked about two bills that will restore the clean up fee to 1 ¼ cents Per gallon. There are substandard tanks that need replacing It would cost us \$1,500 for a new tank compared to \$18,000 dollars for the cleanup of a release.
