Call to Order:

Chairman Bazelmans called the meeting to order at 10:02 AM, verifying that a quorum was present.

Approval of Minutes:

Arthur Cunningham made the motion to accept the September 24, 2015 minutes, Dan Sweet seconded. All in were in favor.

Docket No. 15-09 WMC – Daniel Fournier and Lancaster Auto Sales, LLC Appeal

On September 24, 2015 issued order for status report regarding current site conditions. October 13, 2015 received Assented -to motion to reschedule continuance. On October 14, 2015 issued letter granting Motion to reschedule and scheduled the PHC for November 19, 2015 at 11 AM. On October 14, 2015 received DES Status report requested by Council.

Division Activities & Legislative Update:

Director Michael Wimsatt gave an update on the Budget, The Federal continuing resolution has been held off until December. There have been three positions posted in the Solid Waste Bureau. Clark Freise has been nominated and confirmed by the Governor and Council as the new Assistant Commissioner. Keith DuBois will now return to Waste Management. Thanks go out to Keith for filling in as the acting Assistant Commissioner. There have been some energy improvements to the building, The Bio plant is well under way, updated the lighting and they have begun installing new windows.

There was a meeting regarding the Wells at the Pease Trade port with the citizens' Advisory board the Airport and the Air force. They will be pumping and treating all three wells. The Citizen's Advisory Board will help citizens who have been affected. There have been blood testing done on over 500 hundred people and they are planning to give blood test to another 1500.

The drill conducted at the coast and at the Pease facility was a success. There was a Ship wedge in between the uprights on the Sarah Long Bridge. Number 2 fuel oil leaked. Mr. Wimsatt Wanted to congratulate the staff for running the best training so far. On the water they put out over 2,000 feet of boom. With the strong current in the river the boom did not deploy well. Maine DEP and the US Coast Guard were also on hand. The Coast Guard said that the degree of preparation at our facility that serves as the command post is the best facility on the East Coast, and that the river is the hardest place to deploy.

Consultant's day will be on November 2 at the Radissons Hotel in Manchester.

Rick Berry who used to head up the Spill Response group is now working with Enpro.

John Duclos was available for questions from the Council on the readopting of the Hazardous Waste Rules. The Council will wright a letter of recommendation in support of the rules with the understanding they take their comments into consideration.

Arthur Cunningham mad the motion to except the rule changes Duncan Watson second, all were in favor.
